### GOLF NEWS

#### DAN McCAFFREY TAKES OVER AS SUPERINTENDENT

The entire Seven Lakes organization is extremely pleased to announce that Dan McCaffrey is its new man in charge of maintaining the golf course. He has over 20 years of experience in taking care of golf courses, including the last 11 years as Superintendent of a local club.

Dan has worked directly with golf course architect Bruce Matthews III (who also designed all of the Seven Lakes facilities) to renovate and improve the condition of other courses. This experience will be put to good use in his new position. In fact, only on the second day on the new job, Dan and Bruce collaborated to re-establish the original surface contours and put-

ting nuances of the ninth green on the championship course.

#### Improvements to Greens #9 and #18

Recently, the turf on both the ninth and eighteenth greens has been under stress, and not up to the quality standards expected at Seven Lakes. Upon detailed inspection, Bruce and Dan recommended that the turf be stripped, the original design contours and surface undulations of the two greens be re-established, and new sod installed. This operation will require the use of temporary greens on these two holes for two weeks, but is necessary to ensure the long term, high quality of the course design and condition. Green #9 has already been done, and Green #18 will be done next week.
